# PIANO SECTION

## Category Name – Grades

- Each competitor must perform one piece within the time limit indicated. These pieces **MUST** be from the current AMEB syllabus (Leisure or Comprehensive) except Beginner section.

**CLARIFICATION: Fremantle Eisteddfod defines 'current AMEB syllabus' as the most recent syllabus.**

- Beginner can be any piece not in the AMEB syllabus that is from a beginner book.
- A piano footstool is **NOT** provided by the eisteddfod. We do not promote sharing of footstools.

## Category Name – Bach/Classical/Chopin

- *Includes Bach section\*, Classical Sonata (one movement) section\*\*, Chopin Nocturne section.*

*\*Bach section specifically refers to J.S. Bach.*

*\*\*You **cannot** play a Sonatina in the Sonata section*

## Category Name – Age Group Recital

- Each competitor must perform two or more contrasting pieces (different periods) within the time limit indicated. Pieces do **NOT** have to be in the AMEB syllabus.

## Category Name – Collaborative Pianists

- Duets for one **OR** two pianos - 1 piece only
- Pieces do **NOT** have to be in the AMEB syllabus.

- Own Choice – Two or More Contrasting Works
- Recital pieces must feature two or more parts of harmony
- Different instruments can be combined
- Can include piano accompaniment
- Can include two people per part
- The same person can be in multiple different ensembles competing against each other if the ensembles aren't made up of exactly the same people.

# VOCAL SECTION



## Category Name – Classical, Musical Theatre, Folk Song, Sacred Song or Contemporary Vocal

- No microphone or amplification permitted.
- Musical Theatre: Costume is highly recommended but not required.
- Contemporary Vocal must still be with NO microphone or amplification.
- Classical Vocal Solo includes art song from all countries and languages (art song is lieder in German, mélodie in French, canción in Spanish).
- Sacred Solo includes oratorio and cantata.

## Category Name – Operatic Aria

- All contestants must perform a Mozart aria in addition to their chosen aria in the first round.
- Duration of performance must be stated on the online enrolment form.
- To be sung from memory.

- You cannot play more than one concerto movement per section. Also, you cannot play for example a guitar concerto movement and then also compete in the same section doing a piano concerto movement.
- No option to perform in Winners Concert with this section (but still invited to attend to receive recognition/prize). This is due to only having 1 piano in the Government House Ballroom.
